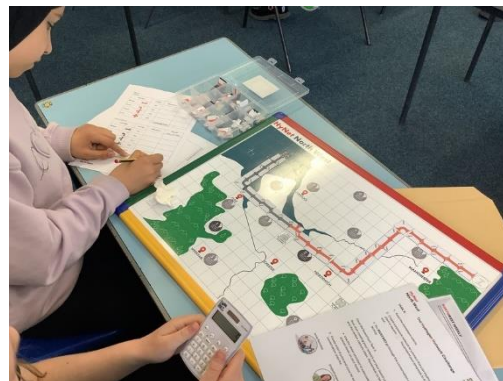
First Aid

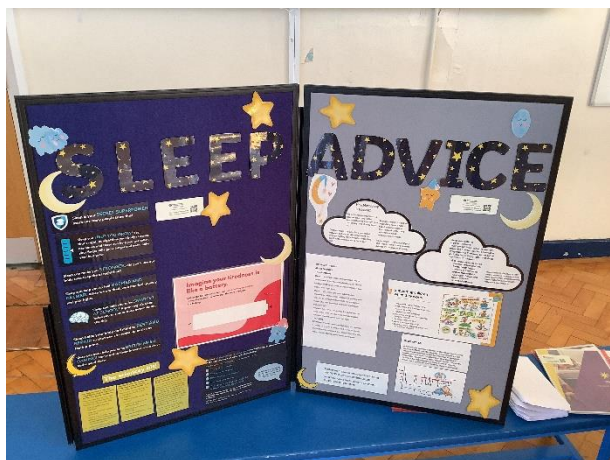
Manchester Early Years Celebration Awards

Last half term, we held the SEND coffee morning which was a really useful and informative morning for parents. We were joined by the Family Hub and the School Nursing Team who spoke to parents about sleep and continence.



Year 6

Youth Workers from Wythenshawe Community Housing Group came in to start working with Year 6 children in their transition to high school. Over the next 4 weeks, mentors from Year 10 at St Paul's will be working with the youth workers and the Year 6 children to make their transition as smooth as possible.

Be Part of Change

On Monday, Jennine from an organisation called Be Part of Change came in to talk to the Year 6 children. Jeannine is a local mum who lost her son to knife crime. She has set up an organisation - Be Part Of Change C.I.C (BPOC) - in memory of her son, where she does workshops in schools for 10–18-year-olds to raise awareness of knife crime. Jeannine shared her son's story and talked about the ripple effect of carrying, picking up a knife and using it on his family, friends and the community.

Jeannine's story was incredibly powerful. The children had opportunity to ask plenty of questions about her experience and were moved by what she had to say.

Jeannine holds a free drop in at Wythenshawe Forum every Friday from 3-6pm. She also runs a free games hub every Monday for 8 to 11 year olds in Crossacres. Please see the flyers at the end of the Newsletter for more details.

SCP Neurodiversity and Education Workshops for Parents/Carers

Understanding and Working with the Education System

For parents/carers of children who are either currently on the Manchester SCP (North, Central or South) waiting list for an autism assessment or who have received a formal diagnosis of autism. Parents/Carers are welcome to attend any session.

- What is available in Manchester to children and families?
- Who can provide advice and support?
