

Important Notice

Following careful consideration of current UK legislation and safety requirements, we have implemented a **complete ban** on e-scooters across our school premises. This decision has been made to ensure we maintain the highest standards of safety for all our children and comply with legal obligations.

Under current UK law, privately owned e-scooters are prohibited from use on public roads, pavements, cycle lanes, and pedestrian areas.

Beyond the legal requirements, we have significant safety concerns regarding e-scooters. These include potential accidents and trip hazards for our children and staff. As a school, we must prioritise the wellbeing of everyone, especially in light of the recent tragic death of a young man in Wythenshawe.

As of today, we ask that you **DO NOT** bring any E-Scooters on to the school premises, as you will be asked to leave. We are no longer allowing them to be walked through the school grounds.

I appreciate your understanding and cooperation in this matter. Together, we can maintain a safe and secure environment where our children can learn and thrive.
